Attractions including LEGOLAND®, the Museum of Making Music and the iconic Flower Fields make Carlsbad an ideal family travel destination. Foodies can explore this vibrant culinary and brewing destination while those looking to relax can enjoy Carlsbad's many spas. Today, Carlsbad continues its legacy as a seaside oasis with opulent spa resorts and numerous day spas catering to various preferences and budgets. From luxurious options to budget-friendly accommodations, Carlsbad is home to acclaimed resorts and hotels, all with a commitment to sustainability. ATTRACTIONS

Opportunities for excitement, enrichment and education abound in Carlsbad, from thrilling excursions to opportunities for insightful cultural exploration. Located near Carlsbad hotels, restaurants and the beach, the following attractions offer unforgettable ways to fill an itinerary for any sun-soaked Carlsbad stay:

- **LEGOLAND®** California Resort: Spanning 128 acres, LEGOLAND® California Resort is filled with more than 60 kid-powered, kid-tastic rides, shows and attractions all built for fun and geared for families with children between the ages of 2 12. Inside LEGOLAND®, enter a world of knights and princesses to conquer the Dragon Coaster; kids can drive their own cars at the Driving School and enjoy character meet and greets, live shows and 4D movie experiences abound at one of the best theme parks in California for children and families. LEGOLAND® is also home to the LEGOLAND® Water Park and SEA LIFE® Aquarium—making it the perfect place to explore over 2-3 days. In 2024, LEGOLAND® California Resort debuted a new land, Dino Valley, with three rides and an interactive zone with a reimagined Dino Dig space with costume character meet and greets. Families also get to experience North America's first-ever LEGO® World Parade, exclusively at LEGOLAND® California Resort during the summer months.
- The Flower Fields at Carlsbad Ranch®: For over sixty years, the rolling hills of Carlsbad have been home to a 55-acre rainbow of Giant Tecolote Ranunculus. The Flower Fields at Carlsbad Ranch®, blooming March-May and open to the public, are set on a hillside overlooking the

striking Southern California coastline. The Flower Fields feature various spring activities and events such as sunset wine tasting, Flower Flow Yoga, flower workshops, concerts and more. The Flower Fields Foundation provides support to The Flower Fields of Carlsbad Ranch for hands-on educational programs for children, charitable grants for low-income schools, an increase in learning environments and special tours for family members of all ages.

- Museum of Making Music: The Museum of Making Music is a cultural destination dedicated to
 the enduring relationship between people, instruments and music. Through interactive exhibits
 in five galleries, the museum showcases the evolution of musical instruments from the late 19th
 century to today. The museum also hosts a variety of concerts and hands-on workshops,
 providing a dynamic introduction to the history of American music products.
- Carlsbad Food Tours: Embark on a culinary journey through Carlsbad Village. Tours provide a local foodie perspective, highlighting Carlsbad Village's laid-back SoCal vibe and culinary delights. During the three-hour walking tour, participants are led by knowledgeable guides and guests can sample treats from unique eateries and specialty shops. This "Taste of Carlsbad" offers a classic overview of local history through food and wine offerings.

BEACHES

Throughout the year, the destination hosts notable events such as the biannual Carlsbad Village Street Faire, a massive street fair with over 900 vendors, international cuisines and musical performances as well as the Carlsbad ArtWalk, which showcases fine art, live music, art for kids and live art. For a year-round cultural immersion, the Museum of Making Music introduces a unique experience with vintage instruments, interactive displays and workshops. The Dea Hurston New Village Arts Center, founded by graduates of New York's Actors Studio Drama School, celebrates over 20 years of award-winning professional theatre and thriving education and outreach programs.

CULINARY

Carlsbad's upscale beachy atmosphere, perfect weather and diverse culinary scene draws visitors seeking new experiences. Standouts include the Michelin-starred Jeune et Jolie, Michelin Bib Gourmand Campfire, all-day restaurant Wildland, newly opened Lilo and Park Hyatt Aviara's Ember & Rye, a collaboration with acclaimed chef and television personality Chef Richard Blais. Carlsbad Village offers myriad options to fit a variety of tastes and budgets and overflowing with flavor including local favorites for fish tacos, seafood, sushi, Mexican and the newest offerings for Himalayan cuisine. Make sure to save room for ice cream and gelato. Carlsbad features nine breweries, four of which (Pure Project, Barrel Republic, Docent Brewing and Pizza Port) are all within walking distance from one another in Carlsbad Village. In an iconic building in Carlsbad, visitors will find the Windmill Food Hall, the place to be for the best from local vendors, plus craft beer selections, creative cocktails and an atmosphere fit for the whole family. Annual culinary events like Oktoberfest and the Taste of Carlsbad Village celebrate the destination's traditional and innovative culinary offerings. Aviara, the immersive wellness experience at the Omni La Costa Resort & Spa, the Cape Rey Carlsbad Beach's Ocean Crest Spa that offers an extensive menu of treatments and The Westin Carlsbad's Ocean Pearl Spa which offers various treatments inspired by the sea. Beyond traditional spas, Carlsbad is the perfect place to embark on a wellness reset; it's a destination that embraces a full mind-body health and wellness journey.

OUTDOOR

Carlsbad is also home to three lagoons (Batiquitos Lagoon, Agua Hedionda Lagoon and Buena Vista Lagoon-the only freshwater lagoon in all of Southern California) covering more than 1,000 acres and including nature preserves, hiking trails, kayaking at California Watersports, ECO Tours at Agua Hedionda Discovery Center and more, taking in some of the most beautiful views in California.
