Call to Order

Meeting called to order by Chair Stripe at 2:02 p.m.

Self-Introductions

Self-introductions were omitted as all in attendance knew each other.

Public Comment

Chair Stripe called for public comments; there was none.

Informational Items

Sidoriak presented the quarterly (April – June 2024) CEO report which included destination performance (STR report) and an update on the 2022-2024 strategic plan.

Chair Stripe provided an update from the Ad Hoc Compensation Committee indicating the CEO goals achieved and related bonus payment. Stripe stated the CEO did a phenomenal job and scored 19 out of 20 points.



Sidoriak then presented preliminary financial information for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2024, including the balance sheet, budget to actual revenues and expenses, Group Incentive Program update, and golf-related assessment summary. A four year projection was also shared to demonstrate the potential spend down of carryover funds.

Sidoriak presented options for the establishment of upcoming regular board meetings and will send a “poll” for all dates to board members to ensure a tentative quorum for each.

Action Items

1. Approval of June 5, 2024 Meeting Minutes

Chair Stripe presented the June 5, 2024 board meeting minutes for approval.

Motion to approve the June 5, 2024 board meeting minutes was made by Stocks; seconded by Buczek.

Motion passed.

2. Approval to Increase President/CEO Expenditure Authority

Stripe explained the rationale and recommendation to increase the current President/CEO expenditure authority from \$100,000 to \$150,000 for budgeted items with no more than a one-year commitment due to the increase in the Visit Carlsbad budget.

Motion to approve the expenditure authority for the current President/CEO for budgeted items with no more than a one-year commitment of \$150,000 was made by Zwirek; seconded by Hart.

Vote: All in favor.

Motion passed.

3. Approval to Increase Board Chair Expenditure Authority

Zwirek explained the rationale and recommendation to increase the current Board Chair expenditure authority from \$150,000 to \$200,000 for budgeted items with no more than a one-year commitment due to the increase in the Visit Carlsbad budget.



Motion to approve the expenditure authority for the current Board Chair for budgeted items with no more than a one-year commitment of \$200,000 was made by Zwirek; seconded by Stocks.

Vote:

4. Grant Application – St. Michael’s Jazz Fest

Sidoriak presented a “Placemaking” grant application from St. Michael’s by-the-Sea for the St. Michael’s Jazz Fest event for \$5,000.

Motion to approve a grant to the St. Michael’s by-the-Sea for St. Michael’s Jazz Fest event for \$2,500 was made by Hart; seconded by Stocks.

Vote: All in favor.

Motion passed.

5. Grant Application – Challenge Walk MS: Southern California

Sidoriak presented a “Placemaking” grant application from the National Multiple Sclerosis Society for the Walk MS: Southern California event for \$5,000.

Motion to approve a grant to the National Multiple Sclerosis Society for the Walk MS: Southern California event for \$5,000 was made by Zwirek; seconded by Hartley.

Vote: All in favor.

Motion passed.

6. Grant Application – Toast of Carlsbad

Sidoriak presented a “Brand Positioning” grant application from Team Player Productions for the Toast of Carlsbad event for \$50,000.

Board members expressed concern over the total budget for the event and the risk of this being a first time event in Carlsbad. The board recommended that the applicant submit total budget details and historical performance for multiple years for events they produce in other destinations and will then reconsider the application.

Motion to deny a grant to Team Player Productions for the Toast of Carlsbad event was made by Stocks; seconded by Hart.



Vote: All in favor.

Motion passed.

7. Approval of CEO Employment Agreement Terms

Stripe presented the terms of a new CEO Employment Agreement with Sidoriak. The Ad Hoc Compensation Committee met several times with Sidoriak. A review of a competitive set from different destination organizations in California was performed and the proposed terms are considered average.

Motion to approve the terms of a new CEO Employment Agreement was made by Zwirek; seconded by Stocks.

Vote: All in favor.

Motion passed.

8. Approval of Extending Carlsbad Good Ride

Sidoriak presented two options for a new contract with Circuit Transit to continue the Carlsbad Good Ride shuttle service. The current contract expires August 31, 2024.

The board conveyed that based on ridership data provided by Circuit compared to the annual cost of the program, it does not make sense financially to continue the service but asked Sidoriak to present other transportation options for the board to consider at a future board meeting.

Motion to not renew a contract with Circuit Transit was made by Stocks; seconded by Hart.

Vote: All in favor.

Motion passed.

9. Adjournment

Chair Stripe called to adjourn the meeting at 4:01 p.m.
